Our rich and truly remarkable HISTORY: From prehistory to post-civil war, we can offer our students the chance to investigate, live and breathe the most significant eras, Neanderthals, Iberians, Phoenicians, Tartessus, Greeks, Carthaginians, Romans, Visigoths, Vandals, Moors to the then new Catholic Monarchs and more recently to modern day post-war era.

From the Roman times, we can 'meet' Seneca, Tajan and Hadrian in Italica, visit the Roman ruins of Acinipo, an important settlement near Ronda, which even had its own coin. Baelo Claudia in Cádiz, Go to Through to the Emirate Al-Andaluz, visiting the Caliphate of Cordoba, exploring the influence this period had on the rest of Europe. And later how the Catholic Monarchs took control of the region and their contribution to the work of Christopher Columbus. This is a crude summary of what can be explored here, but enough to demonstrate the possibilities. Simply put, you let us know which era/s you want to study and we make it happen.
